BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 167.18, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

167.18 DUTY TO DISPOSE OF DEAD BODIES.

No A person who has been caring for or owning-any who owns an animal that has died shall not allow the carcass to lie about the person's premises.
