11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill requires that cash or other qualified security
13 deposited with a clerk of the district court for the purpose
14 of executing an appearance bond, be returned upon the

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RETURN OF CASH OR OTHER QUALIFIED SECURITY DEPOSITED WITH THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT AS BAIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 811.2, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

c. Require the execution of an appearance bond in a specified amount and the deposit with the clerk of the district court or a public officer designated under section 602.1211, subsection 4, in cash or other qualified security of a sum not to exceed ten percent of the amount of the bond, the deposit to be returned to the defendant person who deposited
