3 four hundred fifty thousand (450,000) dollars, or so much
4 thereof as is necessary, to be used for supplemental grants
5 under sections 261.61 and 261.62.

EXPLANATION

7 This bill repeals the supplemental grant program effective
8 July 1, 1989, and provides that for the fiscal year beginning
9 July 1, 1988, an individual receiving a state scholarship is
10 not eligible to receive a supplemental grant. The receipt of
11 a state scholarship will no longer be based upon need and
12 ability, but will be based upon academic achievement. For the
13 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, funding for the
14 supplemental grant program is reduced and the amount of the
15 reduction is appropriated for the state scholarship program.
