In compliance with a written request received January 14 ， 1988 ，a fiscal note for SENATE PILE 2039 is hereby submitted pursuant to joint Rule 17．Data used in developing this fiscal note are available from the legislative fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request．

Senate file 2039 would allow personalized vehicle registration plates to contain up to seven characters（currently six）．

ASSUMPTIONS：
The Department of Transportation would have to purchase new dies at a cost of $\$ 90,000$ ．

Computer programs which record and report the information would have to be modified at a cost to the Department of $\$ 121,000$ if enactment were to occur on July l，1908．The Department has indicated these costs may be substantially reduced if enactment were to occur on January 1,1991 because modifications to the computer system have already been scheduled during this period．Twelve counties which are currently not on the DOT system may also incur costs associated with changing programs．

Last year， 8554 new personalized plates were issued．Based on the experience of the State of Illinois，increasing the number of characters allowed，would increase the demand for new plates by $61 \%$ or about 5,200 new plates at $\$ 2 S$ per plate．After the initial year purchases，the increased demand would also result in an average of 3,000 renewals per year thereafter，at five dollars per renewal．

## FISCAL IMPACT：

First year costs to implement the legislation would be $\$ 211,000$ ；there would be no additional costs in the following years．Allowing for an increase in characters on personalized registration plates is expected to cause an increase in demand．This demand is projected to result ia an increase in revenues of $\$ 130,000$ ，for the first year only．After the first year，ned revenues from renewals would average $\$ 15,000$ per year over che next five years．

1. The transferee shall within fifteen calendar days after purchase or transfer apply for and obtain from the county treasurer of the person's residence, or it a nonresident, the county treasurer of the county where the primary users of the
vehicle are located or the county where all other vehicles owned by the nonresident are registered, a new registration and a new certificate of title for the vehicle except as provided in section 321.25 or 321.48 . The transferee shall present with the application the cectificate of title endorsed and assigned by the previous owner and the-signed-registratien card-or-other-evidence-of-current-registration-ag-required-by the-department shall indicate the name of the county in which the vehicle was last registered and the registration expiration date. The transferee shall be required to list a motor vehicle license number as-part-of-the-apptication-for-a regigtration-transfer-and-o-new-titze---Fhe-motor-vehicie ticense-number-shatz-not-be-the-sociat-security-number-of-the transferee-untess-requested-by-the-transferee.

Sec. 7. Section 321.48 , subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 1. Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

When the transferee of a vehicle is a dealer who holds the vehicle for resale and operates the venicle only for purposes Incident to a resale and displays a dealex plate on the vehicle or does not drive such vehicle or permit it to be driven upon the highways, such transferee shall not be requited to obtain a new reglstration or a new certificate of title but upon transfering title or interest to another person shall execute and acknowledge an assignment and warranty of title upon the certificate of title assigned to the person and deliver the same to the person to whom such transfer is made. Sec. 8. Section 321.52, subsection 2, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:
2. The purchaser or transferee of a motor vehicle for which a certificate of title is issued which is sold for scrap or junk shall surrender the certificate of title and :egzsezation-receipt to the county treasurer of the county fé
residence of the trangferee within fifteen days after assignment of the certificate of title. The county treasurer shall issue to such person without fee a junking certificate. A junking certificate shall authorize the holder to possess. transport or transfer by endorsement the ownershlp of the junked vehicle. A certificate of title shall not again be issued for the vehicle subsequent to the issuance of a junking certificate. the county treasurer shall cancel the record of the vehicle and forward the certificate of title to the department. The junking certificate shall be of a form to allow for the assignment of ounership of the vehicle. The junking certificate shall provide a space for the notation of the transferee of the component parts of the vehicle transferred by the owner of the vehicle.

Sec. 9. Section 321.52, gubsection 3, unnumbered paragraph 1. Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

When a vehicle for which a certificate of title is issued is junked or dismantled by the owner, the ouner shall detach the registration plates and surrender the plates to the county treasurer, unless the plates are properly assigned to another vehicle. The owner shall also surrender the regtstration receipt-and certificate of title to the county treasurer. Upon surrendering the certificate of title, the county treasurer shall issue to the person, without fee, a junking certificate, which shall authorize the holder to possess, transport or transfer ownexship of the junked vehicle by endorsement of the junding certificate. The county treasurer shall hold the surrenderéd certificate of title, registration recelpt and, if applicable, the registration plates for a period of fourteen days following the issuance of a junking certificate under this subsection, Within the fourteen-day period the person who was issued the junking certificate and to whom the vehicle was titled or assigned may surcender to the county treasurer the junking certiticate, and upon the person's payment of app:opriate fees and taxes and payment of
any credit for registration fees received by the person for the vehicle under section 321.46 . subsection 3 , the county treasurer shall issue to the person a certificate of title for the vehicle. After the exploration of the fourteen-day period, a county treasurer shall not issue a certificate of title for a junked vehicle for which a junking certificate is issued. The county treasurer shall cancel the record of the vehicle and forward the certificate of title to the department.

Sec. 10. Section 321.52. subsection 4 , unnumbered paragraph 1. Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

A vehicle rebullder or a motor vehicle dealer licensed under chapter 322, upon acquisition of a wrecked or salvage vehicle, shall surrender the certificate of title and registeation-recetpt or manufacturer's or importer's statement of origin properly assigned, together with an application for a salvage certificate of title to the county treasurer of the county of residence of the purchaser or transferee within fourteen days after the date of assignment of the certificate of title for the wrecked or salvage motor vehicle. This subsection applies only to vehicles with a tit market value of five hundred dollars or more, based on the value before the vehicle became wrecked or salvage. Upon payment of a tee of two dollars, the county treasurer shall issue a salvage certificate of title which shall bear the word "SALVAGE" stamped on the face of the title in bold letters and coded in a manner prescribed by the department. A salvage certificate of title way be assigned to any person. Notwithstanding any other provisions in this section a vehicle on which ownership hae transferred to an insure t of the vehicle, as a result of a settlement wi th the owner of the vehicle arising out of damage to, of unrecovered theft of the vehicle, shall be deemed to be a wrecked or salvage vehicle and the insurer shall comply with this subsection co obtain salvage certificate of title within fourteen days after the date of assignment of the certificate ot title cf the vehicle.

Sec. 11. Section 321.166, subsection S, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:
5. There shall be a marked contrast between the color of the registration plates and the data which is required to be displayed on the registration plates. When a new series of registration plates is issued to replace a current series, the new registration plates shall be of distinctively different color from the series which is replaced, except for collegiate registration plates issued under section 321.34 , subsection 10 .

Sec. 12. Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1990.
