A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the completion of a rest area, including the
2 modernization of its facilities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 2273

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding 1970 Iowa Acts, chapter 1004,
2 section 2, the state department of transportation may complete
3 the construction of the rest area and rest area building on
4 interstate highway thirty-five in Decatur county in the
5 southbound lane, including the modernization of the
6 facilities. If the state department of transportation elects
7 not to complete the construction of the rest area and rest
8 area building, including the modernization of the facilities,
9 the department shall sell the land acquired by the department
10 for the rest area back to the adjacent landowners.

11 EXPLANATION

12 1970 Iowa Act, chapter 1004, prohibited the construction of
13 rest areas or rest area buildings on interstate highways at
14 intervals of less than sixty miles. It required the
15 completion of rest areas under construction on the effective
16 date of the Act, and specifically required the construction of
17 the rest area located on interstate highway thirty-five in
18 Decatur county in the northbound lane, but did not include the
19 rest area in the southbound lane. This bill allows the state
20 department of transportation to complete the construction of
21 the rest area and rest area buildings on the southbound lane
22 in Decatur county, including the modernization of the
23 facilities. If the state department of transportation elects
24 not to complete the construction of the rest area and rest
25 area building, including the modernization of the facilities,
26 the department is required to sell the land acquired for the
27 rest area back to the adjacent landowners.

In compliance with a written request received March 2, 1988, a fiscal note for SENATE FILE 2273 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2273 would allow the Department of Transportation to complete construction of a rest area and rest area building in Decatur county. The Department is required to sell the land back to the adjacent land owners if the rest area and rest area building are not constructed.

FISCAL EFFECT:

The cost of construction of a rest area and building is approximately \$1,126,000. If the land is sold back to adjacent landowners, it would cost approximately \$6,400 to rebuild a fence to maintain required interstate access control. The appraised value of the land is \$5,750.
