In compliance with a written request received March 2, 1988, a fiscal note for SENATR FILE 2291 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2291 provides that funds will be appropriated retroactively from July 1, 1987, from the Iowa public employee's retirement fund rather than the general fund for retirement allowance increases paid to certain retirees. The IPERS' fund will repay the general fund of the state for payments made between July 1, 1987 and the effective date of this Act.

FISCAL EFFECT: This change would provide funding for four separate groups increased benefits from IPERS rather than the general fund. This would increase costs to IPERS and reduce general fund expenditures. The costs/savings by group are estimated as follows:

The person's allowance for prior service credits shall be computed in the same manner as otherwise provided in this section, but shall not exceed the sum of four hundred fifty dollars nor be less than three hundred dollars per annum. Any such person is entitled to receive retirement

allowances computed as provided by this chapter, effective from the date of application to the department, provided such application is approved. However, beginning July 1, 1975 the amount of such person's retirement allowance payment received during June, 1975, as computed under this section shall be increased by two hundred percent and the allowance for prior service credits shall not exceed one thousand three hundred fifty dollars nor be less than nine hundred dollars per annum. There Effective July 1, 1987, there is appropriated for each fiscal year from the general Iowa public employees' retirement fund of-the-state created in section 978.7 to the department of personnel from-funds-not-otherwise-appropriated an amount sufficient to fund the provisions-of retirement allowance increases paid under this paragraph. For each member employed before January 1, 1976, who has qualified for prior service credit in accordance with the first paragraph of section 978.43, there shall be determined a benefit of eight-tenths of one percent per year of prior service credit multiplied by the monthly rate of the member's total remuneration not in excess of three thousand dollars annually during the twelve consecutive months of the member's prior service for which that total remuneration was the highest. An additional three-tenths of one percent of the remuneration not in excess of three thousand dollars annually shall be payable for prior service during each year in which the accrued liability for benefit payments created by the abolished system is funded by appropriation from the general fund-of-the-state lowe public employees' retirement fund.
