TO PROVIDE THAT A LEASED MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE REGISTERED IN THE COUNTY OF THE LESSEE'S RESIDENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.20, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

Except as provided in this chapter, every an owner of a vehicle subject to registration shall make application to the county treasurer, of the county of the owner's residence, or if a nonresident, to the county treasurer of the county where the primary users of the vehicle are located, or if a lessor of the vehicle pursuant to chapter 321F which vehicle has a gross vehicle weight of less than ten thousand pounds, to the county treasurer of the county of the lessee's residence, for the registration and issuance of a certificate of title for the vehicle upon the appropriate form furnished by the department, accompanied by a fee of ten dollars, and every the application shall bear the signature of the owner written with pen and ink.
