RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARDS, BY
AUTHORIZING THE CHARGING OF CERTAIN COUNTY PARK FEES AND
BY PROHIBITING THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF COUNTY PARKS BY ONE
OR MORE ORGANIZATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 111A.4, subsection 7, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

7. To charge and collect reasonable fees for the use of such the parks, facilities, privileges and conveniences as may be provided and for admission to amateur athletic contests, demonstrations and exhibits, and other noncommercial events.
