Section 1.. Section lo9B.4, subsection 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

1. A person shall not use or operate commercial gear without-possessing unless at least one individual at the site where the commercial gear is being operated possesses an appropriate valid commercial license, or a designated operator's license. A license is valid from the date of issue to January 10 of the steeeeding calendar year after the calendar year for which it was issued.

Sec. 2. Section 109B.4, subsection 2, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:
2. It is lawful for a commercial Eisher to designate a person as a designated operator to lift and to fish with any or all licensed commercial Eishing gear owned by the commercial fisher. As a resuit, each commercial fisher may obtain up to five designated operators licenses for use by the fisher's employees and the fisher may issue those licenses to differing employees each day.
