BACKGROUND STATEMENT 9 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY 10 Sections 1, 3, and 4 require that an individual possessing ll a valid commercial fisher or helper license be at each site 12 where fish, turtles, or mussels are being taken as part of a 13 commercial operation. Section 2 removes the requirement to have the name of the 15 designated operator specified on each designated operator's 16 license issued to a commercial fisher. As a result, each 17 commercial fisher may obtain up to five designated operators 18 licenses for use by the fisher's employees and the fisher may 19 issue those licenses to differing employees each day. 20 However, the designated operator must be in possession of a 21 designated operator's license when lifting or using any 22 commercial fishing gear. 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE AND POSSESSION OF COMMERCIAL FISHING OPERATORS' LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF 10WA:

Section 1. Section 109B.4, subsection 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

- 1. A person shall not use or operate commercial gear without-possessing unless at least one individual at the site where the commercial gear is being operated possesses an appropriate valid commercial license, or a designated operator's license. A license is valid from the date of issue to January 10 of the succeeding calendar year for-which-it-was issued.
- Sec. 2. Section 1098.4, subsection 2, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Etmismiswfulmforma A commercial fisher to may designate a person as a designated operator to lift and to fish with any or-all licensed commercial fishing gear owned by the commercial fisher. The-commercial-fisher-shall-submit the names-and-addresses-of-the-persons-to-be-designated-as designated-operators-when-applying-for-a-commercial-fishing license: A commercial fisher shall not have more than five designated operators. A designated operator's license shall be assigned to not more than three operators during a year and a designated operator's license shall be valid for use only by an operator who possesses the license and has signed the license. The signature of any preceding designated operator who possessed the license shall be crossed out. A designated operator shall not lift or fish any commercial fishing gear without having-first-procured possessing a designated operator's license which is signed by the operator. A designated operator's license which is not signed by the operator in possession of the license is forfeited to the

NEW PARAGRAPH. d. An individual possessing a valid commercial turtle license may have the assistance of one unlicensed individual in the commercial taking of turtles.

Sec. 4. Section 1098.12, subsection 1. Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new lettered paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. d. An individual possessing a valid commercial mussel license may have the assistance of one unlicensed individual in the commercial taking of mussels.
