SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

Iowa Code section 144.13 does not currently state who is responsible for entering the name of the father on the certificate of birth when there has been a court determination of paternity. Occasionally court-determined paternity actions contain incomplete information. Hospitals do not routinely receive copies of court orders establishing paternity, and the public is often confused about when a court order or paternity affidavit may be used. Naming the Iowa department of public health as the responsible party for entering paternity changes on certificates of birth will reduce confusion and ensure accurate information on the certificates.

Section 1. Section 144.13, unnumbered paragraphs 2 and 3, Code 1989, are amended to read as follows:

If the mother was married either at the time of conception or birth, the name of the husband shall be entered on the certificate as the father of the child unless paternity has been determined otherwise by a court of competent jurisdiction, in which case the name of the father as determined by the court shall be entered by the department.
