18 some of these actions should be accomplished by a birth
19 certificate change as provided for in paternity matters under
20 Iowa Code section 144.13. Additionally, name changes for
21 minors require either the written consent of both parents or a
22 hearing on the petition as provided in Iowa Code section
23 674.6. Requiring a certified copy of the birth certificate
24 indicating parentage when petitioning for a name change will
25 reduce confusion and help the department of public health
26 respond appropriately to name change requests.
