1 Section 1. Section 321.236, subsection 1, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 2 and paragraph a, Code 1989, are amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 Parking meter, and snow route, and overtime parking  
5 violations which are denied shall be charged and proceed  
6 before a court the same as other traffic violations and court  
7 costs shall be assessed as provided in section 805.6,  
8 subsection 1, paragraph "a" for parking violation cases.

9 Parking violations which are admitted:

10 a. May be charged and collected upon a simple notice of a  
11 fine ~~not-exceeding-five-dollars~~ payable to the city clerk or  
12 clerk of the district court, if authorized by ordinance. The  
13 fine shall not exceed five dollars except for snow route  
14 parking violations in which case the fine shall not exceed  
15 twenty-five dollars. No costs or other charges shall be  
16 assessed. All fines collected by a city pursuant to this  
17 paragraph shall be retained by the city and all fines  
18 collected by a county pursuant to this paragraph shall be  
19 retained by the county.

20 Sec. 2. Section 805.8, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code  
21 Supplement 1989, is amended to read as follows:

22 a. For parking violations under sections 321.236, 321.239,  
23 321.358, 321.360, and 321.361, the scheduled fine is five  
24 dollars. However, violations charged by a city or county  
25 upon simple notice of a fine instead of a uniform citation and  
26 complaint as permitted by section 321.236, subsection 1,  
27 paragraph "a", are not scheduled violations, and this section  
28 shall not apply to any offense charged in that manner. For a  
29 parking violation under section 111.38 or 321.362 the  
30 scheduled fine is ten dollars.

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill allows local authorities to impose up to a \$25  
33 fine for snow route parking violations by a simple notice of  
34 fine. Fines collected upon a simple notice of fine are not  
35 subject to other costs or charges and are retained by the city

AN ACT

REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON SNOW ROUTES, AND  
PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.236, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 2 and paragraph a, Code 1989, are amended to read as follows:

Parking meter, and snow route, and overtime parking violations which are denied shall be charged and proceed before a court the same as other traffic violations and court costs shall be assessed as provided in section 805.6, subsection 1, paragraph "a" for parking violation cases. Parking violations which are admitted:

a. May be charged and collected upon a simple notice of a fine ~~not-exceeding-five-dollars~~ payable to the city clerk or clerk of the district court, if authorized by ordinance. The fine shall not exceed five dollars except for snow route parking violations in which case the fine shall not exceed twenty-five dollars. No costs or other charges shall be assessed. All fines collected by a city pursuant to this paragraph shall be retained by the city and all fines collected by a county pursuant to this paragraph shall be retained by the county.

Sec. 2. Section 805.8, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code Supplement 1989, is amended to read as follows:

a. For parking violations under sections 321.236, 321.239, 321.358, 321.360, and 321.361, the scheduled fine is five dollars. However, violations charged by a city or county upon simple notice of a fine instead of a uniform citation and complaint as permitted by section 321.236, subsection 1, paragraph "a", are not scheduled violations, and this section

shall not apply to any offense charged in that manner. For a parking violation under section 111.38 or 321.362 the scheduled fine is ten dollars.
