AN ACT RELATING TO AIRPORT ZONING REGULATIONS BY ALLOWING CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL AVIATION REGULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 329.10, subsections 2 and 3, Code 1989, are amended to read as follows:
