RELATING TO CIVIL DAMAGES AND LICENSE REVOCATION FOR ILLEGAL TAKING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 109.130, subsection 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

1. For each elk, antelope, buffalo, or moose, one two thousand five hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. Section 110.21, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:
