1 Section 1. Section 321.260, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 1989, is amended to read as follows:

3 Any A person who willfully and intentionally, without
4 lawful authority, attempts to or in fact alters, defaces,
5 injures, knocks down, or removes ~~any~~ an official traffic-
6 control device, ~~any~~ an authorized warning sign or signal or
7 barricade, whether temporary or permanent, ~~any~~ a railroad sign
8 or signal, ~~any~~ an inscription, shield or insignia on any of
9 such devices, signs, signals, or barricades, or any other part
10 thereof, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a serious
11 misdemeanor and shall be required to make restitution to the
12 affected jurisdiction.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill requires a person who is convicted of interfering
15 with a traffic device, sign, or signal under section 321.260
16 to make restitution to the affected jurisdiction.

REQUIRING RESTITUTION OF PERSONS CONVICTED OF INTERFERING
WITH A TRAFFIC DEVICE, SIGN, OR SIGNAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.260, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

Any A person who willfully and intentionally, without lawful authority, attempts to or in fact alters, defaces, injures, knocks down, or removes any an official traffic-control device, any an authorized warning sign or signal or barricade, whether temporary or permanent, any a railroad sign or signal, any an inscription, shield or insignia on any of such devices, signs, signals, or barricades, or any other part thereof, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a serious
