1 Section 1.

2 There is appropriated from those funds designated within
3 the energy conservation trust created in section 93.11, to the
4 energy and geological resources division of the department of
5 natural resources for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990,
6 and ending June 30, 1991, the following amounts, or so much
7 thereof as is necessary, for disbursement under section 93.11
8 to the following agencies for the purposes designated:

9 1. To the department of natural resources for the
10 following purposes:

11 a. For deposit in the oil overcharge account of the
12 groundwater protection fund created pursuant to section
13 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph "e", and allocated as
14 provided from the Stripper well fund:

15 \$ 2,700,000

16 b. For the state energy conservation program and for the
17 energy extension service program, from the Exxon fund:

18 \$ 238,200

19 c. For the establishment and implementation of not less
20 than five model farm demonstration project areas, in
21 geographically distinct portions of the state. The projects
22 shall be located in southeast, south-central, southwest,
23 northwest, and north-central portions of the state. The
24 projects shall be designed to enhance the profitability and
25 decrease the environmental impacts of row crop production, and
26 to develop on-farm demonstration and education programs
27 involving farms concentrated in a project area, such as the
28 Big Spring demonstration project does in northeast Iowa. An
29 advisory group shall assist the energy and geological
30 resources division of the department of natural resources in
31 the project design and implementation, with representation
32 consisting of the directors of the soil conservation division
33 of the department of agriculture and land stewardship, and the
34 cooperative extension service. From the Stripper well fund:

1 2. To the division of community action agencies of the
2 department of human rights for qualifying energy conservation
3 programs for low-income persons, including but not limited to
4 energy weatherization projects, which target the highest

7 and the office of hearings and appeals second-stage settlement
8 fund, and supplemented by the Exxon fund for a total
9 appropriation not to exceed:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

There is appropriated from those funds designated within the energy conservation trust created in section 93.11, to the energy and geological resources division of the department of natural resources for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990, and ending June 30, 1991, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for disbursement under section 93.11 to the following agencies for the purposes designated:

- 1. To the department of natural resources for the following purposes:
 - a. For deposit in the oil overcharge account of the groundwater protection fund created pursuant to section 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph "e", and allocated as provided from the Stripper well fund:
 - \$ 2,700,000
 - b. For the state energy conservation program and for the energy extension service program, from the Exxon fund:
 - \$ 238,200
- 2. To the department of agriculture and land stewardship for the establishment and implementation of not less than five model farm demonstration project areas, in geographically distinct portions of the state. The projects shall be located in southeast, south-central, southwest, northwest, and north-central portions of the state. The projects shall be designed to enhance the profitability and decrease the environmental

impacts of row crop production, and to develop on-farm demonstration and education programs involving farms concentrated in a project area, such as the Big Spring demonstration project does in northeast Iowa. An advisory group shall assist the soil conservation division of the department of agriculture and land stewardship in the project design and implementation, with representation consisting of the energy and geological resources division of the department of natural resources and the cooperative extension service. From the Stripper well fund:

Moneys appropriated under this subsection shall only be appropriated in an amount which does not exceed the balance of moneys returned from payments on the revolving loan used to fund the Quad Cities intermodal project, at the time of execution of the contract with the regional planning agency. The department shall coordinate the demonstration study with the department of economic development and shall report to the general assembly, not later than March 31, 1991, on the outcome of the study, on the applicability of integrating intermodal transportation analysis into regional economic development studies, and on the contribution that regional planning can make to statewide planning.
