A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the membership of the long-term care
2 coordinating unit within the department of elder affairs.
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6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill increases the membership of the long-term care
8 coordinating unit within the department of elder affairs to
9 include the director of the department of inspections and
10 appeals and two members appointed by the governor.

11 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

12 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

13 This bill increases the membership of the long-term care
14 coordinating unit in section 249D.58, subsection 1, of the
15 Code by adding the following new members:

16 1. The director of the department of inspections and
17 appeals.

18 2. Two public members appointed by the governor.

19 Including the director of the department of inspections and
20 appeals will provide a forum for communication of problems in
21 the nursing home component of the long-term care coordinating
22 unit. The two public members currently serving on the unit
23 cannot vote. It is important that they be able to enjoy full
24 membership privileges.

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AN ACT
RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE LONG-TERM CARE
COORDINATING UNIT WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 249D.58, subsection 1, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new paragraphs:

NEW PARAGRAPH. d. The director of the department of inspections and appeals.

NEW PARAGRAPH. e. Two members appointed by the governor.
