      This bill increases the cost of a certificate of
13 registration for a person holding a federal kennel or dealers
14 license from $5 to $20. The cost of a certificate of
15 registration for a federally licensed commercial breeder was
16 increased from $5 to $20 last session. This bill would
17 conform the remaining registration fees to that increase.

AN ACT

RELATING TO INCREASING LICENSE FZES FOR CERTAIN PERSONS EN-GAGED IN THE COMMERCIAL CARE OF ANIMALS.

BE IT PRACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 162.6. Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

162.6 COMMERCIAL KENNEL OR PUBLIC AUCTION LICENSE.

A person shall not operate a commercial kennel or public auction unless the person has obtained a license to operate a commercial kennel or a public auction issued by the secretary or unless the person has obtained a certificate of registration issued by the secretary if the kennel is federally licensed. Application for the license or the certificate shall be made in the manner provided by the secretary. The license and the certificate expire one year from date of issue unless revoked. The license fee is forty dollars per year and the certification fee is five twenty dollars annually. If the person has obtained a federal license, the person need only obtain a certificate. The license may be renewed upon application and payment of the prescribed fee in the manner provided by the secretary if the licensee has conformed to all statutory and regulatory requirements. The certificate may be renewed upon application and payment of the prescribed fee in the manner provided by the secretary.

Sec. 2. Section 162.7, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

162.7 DEALER LICENSE.

A person shall not operate as a dealer unless the person has obtained a license issued by the secretary or unless the person has obtained a certificate of registration issued by

the secretary if the kennel is federally licensed. Application for the license or the certificate shall be made in the manner provided by the secretary. The license and certificate expire one year from date of issue unless revoked. The license fee is one hundred dollars per year and the certification fee is five twenty dollars per year. The license may be renewed upon application and payment of the fee in the manner provided by the secretary if the licensee has conformed to all statutory and regulatory requirements. The certificate may be renewed upon application and payment of the fee in the manner provided by the secretary.
