1 Section 1. Section 162.6, Code 1989, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 162.6 COMMERCIAL KENNEL OR PUBLIC AUCTION LICENSE.

4 A person shall not operate a commercial kennel or public
5 auction unless the person has obtained a license to operate a
6 commercial kennel or a public auction issued by the secretary
7 or unless the person has obtained a certificate of
8 registration issued by the secretary if the kennel is
9 federally licensed. Application for the license or the
10 certificate shall be made in the manner provided by the
11 secretary. The license and the certificate expire one year
12 from date of issue unless revoked. The license fee is forty
13 dollars per year and the certification fee is five twenty
14 dollars annually. If the person has obtained a federal
15 license, the person need only obtain a certificate. The
16 license may be renewed upon application and payment of the
17 prescribed fee in the manner provided by the secretary if the
18 licensee has conformed to all statutory and regulatory
19 requirements. The certificate may be renewed upon application
20 and payment of the prescribed fee in the manner provided by
21 the secretary.

22 Sec. 2. Section 162.7, Code 1989, is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 162.7 DEALER LICENSE.

25 A person shall not operate as a dealer unless the person
26 has obtained a license issued by the secretary or unless the
27 person has obtained a certificate of registration issued by
28 the secretary if the kennel is federally licensed.
29 Application for the license or the certificate shall be made
30 in the manner provided by the secretary. The license and
31 certificate expire one year from date of issue unless revoked.
32 The license fee is one hundred dollars per year and the
33 certification fee is five twenty dollars per year. The
34 license may be renewed upon application and payment of the fee
35 in the manner provided by the secretary if the licensee has

1 conformed to all statutory and regulatory requirements. The
2 certificate may be renewed upon application and payment of the
3 fee in the manner provided by the secretary.

4 EXPLANATION

5 This bill increases from five to twenty dollars the annual
6 certification fee required to be obtained either by a
7 federally licensed commercial dealer of dogs or cats or by a
8 federally licensed commercial kennel or public auction, as
9 provided under chapter 162.

10 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

11 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

12 This bill increases the cost of a certificate of
13 registration for a person holding a federal kennel or dealers
14 license from \$5 to \$20. The cost of a certificate of
15 registration for a federally licensed commercial breeder was
16 increased from \$5 to \$20 last session. This bill would
17 conform the remaining registration fees to that increase.

AN ACT

RELATING TO INCREASING LICENSE FEES FOR CERTAIN PERSONS EN-
GAGED IN THE COMMERCIAL CARE OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 162.6, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

162.6 COMMERCIAL KENNEL OR PUBLIC AUCTION LICENSE.

A person shall not operate a commercial kennel or public auction unless the person has obtained a license to operate a commercial kennel or a public auction issued by the secretary or unless the person has obtained a certificate of registration issued by the secretary if the kennel is federally licensed. Application for the license or the certificate shall be made in the manner provided by the secretary. The license and the certificate expire one year from date of issue unless revoked. The license fee is forty dollars per year and the certification fee is five ~~twenty~~ dollars annually. If the person has obtained a federal license, the person need only obtain a certificate. The license may be renewed upon application and payment of the prescribed fee in the manner provided by the secretary if the licensee has conformed to all statutory and regulatory requirements. The certificate may be renewed upon application and payment of the prescribed fee in the manner provided by the secretary.

Sec. 2. Section 162.7, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

162.7 DEALER LICENSE.

A person shall not operate as a dealer unless the person has obtained a license issued by the secretary or unless the person has obtained a certificate of registration issued by

the secretary if the kennel is federally licensed. Application for the license or the certificate shall be made in the manner provided by the secretary. The license and certificate expire one year from date of issue unless revoked. The license fee is one hundred dollars per year and the certification fee is five ~~twenty~~ dollars per year. The license may be renewed upon application and payment of the fee in the manner provided by the secretary if the licensee has conformed to all statutory and regulatory requirements. The certificate may be renewed upon application and payment of the fee in the manner provided by the secretary.
