Section 1. Section 357E.3, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

The supervisors shall, on the petition of twenty-five percent of the resident property owners in of a proposed district if the assessed valuation of the property owned by the petitioners represents at least twenty-five percent of the total assessed value of the proposed district, hold a public hearing concerning the establishment of a proposed district.
