1 Section 1. Section 135.93, Code 1989, is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 135.93 SCOPE OF LICENSE -- DURATION.

Licenses for hospice programs shall be issued only for the 4 5 premises, person, hospital, or facility named in the 6 application and are not transferable or assignable. A 7 license, unless sooner suspended or revoked, shall expire two 8 years after the date of issuance and shall be renewed 9 biennially upon an application by the licensee. Application 10 for renewal shall be made in writing to the department, 11 accompanied-by-the-fee-required-to-cover-the-cost-cf 12 administering-the-program, at least thirty days prior to the 13 expiration of the license. The fee for a license renewal 14 shall be determined by the department. Licensed hospice 15 programs which have allowed their licenses to lapse through 16 failure to make timely application for renewal shall pay an 17 additional fee of twenty-five percent of the biennial license 18 fee.

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EXPLANATION

The bill deletes language which bases the fee required for hospice licensure renewal upon the administration of the program and deletes language requiring the submittal of the fee at the time of application for renewal.
