A BILL FOR 1 An Act providing for the refund of unexpired registration fees for certain vehicles registered as special mobile equipment and providing an effective date. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.21, Code 1989, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. a. If a vehicle was registered as
- 4 special mobile equipment prior to July 1, 1988, and the
- 5 vehicle, as of July 1, 1988, no longer was required to be
- 6 registered as special mobile equipment pursuant to 1988 Iowa
- 7 Acts, chapter 1083, sections 1 and 2, the owner in whose name
- 8 the vehicle was registered may make claim to the state
- 9 department of transportation for a refund of the vehicle's
- 10 registration fee subject to the following:
- (1) The refund shall be computed on the basis of the
- 12 number of unexpired months remaining in the registration year
- 13 on July 1, 1988, and shall be rounded to the nearest whole
- 14 dollar. Section 321.127, subsection 1, does not apply.
- 15 (2) The refund shall only be allowed if the owner provides
- 16 the credit copy of the registration receipt for the vehicle.
- 17 (3) The refund computed under subparagraph (1) shall only
- 18 be allowed to the extent the amount computed exceeds five
- 19 dollars.
- 20 b. This subsection is repealed effective July 1, 1992.
- 21 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 22 takes effect upon its enactment.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 1988 Towa Acts, chapter 1083, sections 1 and 2, changed
- 25 definitions of implement of husbandry and special mobile
- 26 equipment effective July 1, 1988. This bill provides that
- 27 owners of vehicles registered as special mobile equipment
- 28 prior to July 1, 1988, which are no longer regulred to be
- 29 registered because of operation of 1988 Iowa Acts, chapter
- 30 1083, sections 1 and 2, may make claim to the state department
- 31 of transportation for a refund. The refund is to be rounded
- 32 to the nearest whole dollar and is to be computed on the basis
- 33 of the number of unexpired months remaining in the
- 34 registration period on July 1, 1988. However, the refund is
- 35 only allowed to the extent the computed refund amount exceeds

      The bill takes effect upon its enactment and is repealed

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## HOUSE FILE 475 FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for HOUSE FILE 475 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 475 requires the Towa Department of Transportation to refund the unexpired portion of registration fees for certain vehicles registered as special mobile equipment.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

Special mobile equipment plates are issued for a three year period, and expire on December 31 of the third year following issuance. The fee is \$15. The bill computes the refund on the basis of the number of unexpired months remaining in the registration year, beginning on July 1, 1988; however, the bill provides the refund only to the extent that it exceeds \$5.

## FISCAL EFFECT:

The estimated cost to refund all registration fees, if all claims are made, will be \$62,500, which will be credited from the Road Use Tax Fund.

## AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE REFUND OF UNEXPIRED REGISTRATION FEES FOR CERTAIN VEHICLES REGISTERED AS SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IONA:

Section 1. Section 321.21, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

<u>MEW SUBSECTION</u>, 8. a. If a vehicle was registered as special mobile equipment prior to July 1, 1988, and the vehicle, as of July 1, 1988, no longer was required to be registered as special mobile equipment pursuant to 1988 Idwa Acts, chapter 1083, sections 1 and 2, the owner in whose name the vehicle was registered may make claim to the state department of transportation for a refund of the vehicle's registration fee subject to the following:

- (1) The refund shall be computed on the basis of the number of unexpired months remaining in the registration year on July 1, 1988, and shall be rounded to the hearest whole dollar. Section 321.127, subsection 1, does not apply.
- (2) The refund shall only be allowed if the owner provides the credit copy of the registration receipt for the vehicle.
- (3) The refund computed under subparagraph (1) shall only be allowed to the extent the amount computed exceeds five dollars.
  - b. This subsection is repealed effective July 1, 1992.

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Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon its enactment.
