House File 578 excludes from income, for purposes of state and local government benefit or entitlement programs and for the state individual income tax the proceeds received by a disabled veteran or the beneficiary of a disabled veteran from a judgement in or settlement of a lawsuit against the manufacturers or distributors of a herbicide, including Agent Orange, used in the Vietnam Conflict for damages resulting from exposure to the herbicide.

The exemption from state income tax applies retroactively to January 1, 1989, for tax years beginning on or after that date.

Fiscal Effect


