The bill also provides for review of procurement practices by the department of general services and the department of naturai resources. The department of natural resources is required to assist the agencies in locating suppiiers of and collecting data. The department of general services is required to report to the gereeral assembly information reiating to recyclable products and starch-based and soybean-based products purchased by the state.

 FISCAL NOTEA fiscai note for House File 656 is hereby submicted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the legislative Fiscal Bureau to memioers of the Legislature upon request.

House Fiie 656 requires that purchases by the Department of General Services, Departmen: of Transportation, State Bcard of Regents, and the Commission for the Blind, of soybean-based inks used for newsprinting services and of starch-based garbage can liners shall increase by July 1,1990 , to one hundred percent of the total purchases of inks used for newsprinting services and garbage can liners. It provides for the review of procurement practices by the Department of Generai Services and the Department of Natural Resources. The Department of Natural Resources is required to assist the agencies in locating suppliers of and collecting data. The Department of General Services is required to report to the General Assembly relating ro recyclable products and starch-based and soybean-based products purchased by the State.

Assumptions:

1. Soybean-based inks must be used in $100 \%$ of newspaper procurements effective July l, 1990. The cost of the ink is only siightly higher than petroieum-based inks and does not substantially increa:e the costs of newsprint jobs.
2. The procurement of starch-based garbage bags from $15 \%$ to $100 \%$ is effective Juiy 1, 1990. The cost of starch-based bags would increase the cost for central State government by $\$ 14,000$ and $\$ 60,000$ for both Iowa State University and University of Northern Iowa. (costs were not available for the University of Iowa.)

Fiscal Impact: The fiscal impact of HF 656 is estimated at $\$ 14,000$ for central
State government and $\$ 60,000$ for the Board of Regents institutions.

NEW PARAGRAPH. j. The department of general services and the department of natural resources shall cooperate with the commission in all phases of implementing this section.

NEW PARAGRAPH. k. As used in this section "plastic product" means a product containing plastic equal to at least fifty percent of the weight of the product.

## EXPLANATION

This bill requires the department of general services, the state department of transportation, the state board of regents, and the commission for the blind to purchase recycled paper, starch-based plastics, soybean-based inks, and recycled plastic products and refrain from purchasing styrofoam cortainers and packages, according to an established schecule. The bill also provides for review of procurement practices by the department of general services and the department of natural resources. The department of natural resources is required to assist the agencies in locating suppliers of and collecting data. The department of general services is required to report to the general assembly information relating to recyclable products and starch-based and soybeanbased products purchased by the state.
