1 Section 1. Section 321.275, Code 1989, is amended by
2 adding the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 9. BICYCLE SAFETY FLAGS REQUIRED ON
4 MOTORIZED BICYCLES. When operated on a highway, a motorized
5 bicycle shall have a bicycle safety flag which extends not
6 less than five feet above the ground attached to the rear of
7 the motorized bicycle. The bicycle safety flag shall be
8 triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty
9 square inches, and be day-glow in color.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill requires motorized bicycles, when operated on the
12 highways, to have bicycle safety flags. The flags shall
13 extend not less than five feet above the ground attached to
14 the rear of the motorized bicycle. Each flag shall be day-
15 glow in color and be triangular in shape with an area of not
16 less than thirty square inches.

17 These provisions are similar to those applicable to all-
18 terrain vehicles under section 321.234A.

19 A violation has a scheduled fine of fifteen dollars subject
20 to surcharge and court costs.

Section 1. Section 321.275, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

I hereby certify that this bill originated in the House and is known as House File 663, Seventy-third General Assembly.

NEW SUBSECTION. 9. BICYCLE SAFETY FLAGS REQUIRED ON MOTORIZED BICYCLES. When operated on a highway, a motorized bicycle shall have a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet above the ground attached to the rear of the motorized bicycle.
