23 This bill provides for the creation and financing by cities

25 suitable for automated mapping and facilities mapping. The  
26 data bases will permit cities, counties, and private  
27 enterprises to combine, and make readily available, existing  
28 information now stored manually in widely separated areas. In  
29 addition to uses for public safety and governmental  
30 operations, data bases will aid the private sector with regard  
31 to economic development. The cost of the data base system  
32 will be recovered through user fees; therefore, confidential  
33 records status is included in the bill to enable cities and  
34 counties to control access to the system and recover the  
35 economic value of private use.
