1 Section 1. Section 107.6A, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
2 1989, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. Operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of
4 alcohol or a drug or a combination of such substances or while
5 having an alcohol concentration of .10 or more, in violation
6 of section 321J.2. Upon a plea or verdict of guilty of a
7 violation of this paragraph, the court shall order the state
8 department of transportation to revoke the defendant's motor
9 vehicle license or nonresident operating privileges for a
10 period of six years. The defendant shall surrender to the
11 court any Iowa license or permit and the court shall forward
12 it to the department with a copy of the revocation order.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that upon a plea or verdict of guilty of
15 the crime of vehicular homicide where the operator is under
16 the influence of alcohol or a drug or while having an alcohol
17 concentration level of .10 or greater, the court shall order
18 the state department of transportation to revoke the
19 defendant's motor vehicle license or nonresident operating
20 privileges for six years.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REVOCATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE OR
NONRESIDENT OPERATING PRIVILEGE AS THE RESULT OF A
CONVICTION FOR CERTAIN VEHICULAR HOMICIDE OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

SECTION 1. Section 202.5A, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
1989, is amended to read as follows:

a. Operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of
alcohol or a drug or a combination of such substances or while
having an alcohol concentration of .10 or more in violation
of section 202.2. Upon a plea of guilty of a
violation of this paragraph, the court shall order the state
department of transportation to revoke the defendant's motor
vehicle license or nonresident operating privilege for a
period of six years. The defendant shall surrender to the
