7 to be chosen at the next general election for members of the
8 General Assembly, and the Secretary of State is directed to
9 cause the amendment to be published for three consecutive
10 months before the date of that election as provided by law.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This proposed constitutional amendment repeals the
13 constitutional provision which forever disqualifies
14 participants of a duel from holding office.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IOWA
REMOVING THE DISQUALIFICATION FROM OFFICE FOR PARTIES TO A
DUEL.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is proposed:

1. Section 5 of Article I of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is repealed.

Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members of the General Assembly, and the Secretary of State is directed to cause the amendment to be published for three
