1 Section 1. Section 109.123, Code 1989, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 109.123 PROHIBITED HUNTING NEAR BUILDINGS.

50154 1. A person shall not discharge a firearm at any game or
50155 fur-bearing animal within two hundred yards of a building
6 inhabited by people or domestic livestock or within two
7 hundred yards of a feedlot unless the owner or tenant has
8 given consent.

50159 2. As used in this section, "feedlot" means a lot, yard,
10 corral, or other area in which livestock are confined,
11 primarily for the purposes of feeding and growth before
12 slaughter. The term does not include areas which are used for
13 the raising of crops or other vegetation and upon which
14 livestock are allowed to graze or feed.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill prohibits the discharge of a firearm within two
17 hundred feet of a feedlot without the consent of the owner or
18 tenant.

19 A violator is guilty of a misdemeanor which is a fine of
20 not more than one hundred dollars or imprisonment for not more
21 than thirty days.

TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS NEAR A FEEDLOT AND SUBJECTING VIOLATORS TO EXISTING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 109.123, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

109.123 PROHIBITED HUNTING NEAR BUILDINGS.

1. A person shall not discharge a firearm at any game or fur-bearing animal within two hundred yards of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock or within two hundred yards of a feedlot unless the owner or tenant has given consent.

2. As used in this section, "feedlot" means a lot, yard, corral, or other area in which livestock are present and confined, for the purposes of feeding and growth before slaughter. The term does not include areas which are used for
