8 appointed official.

9 b. The earnings of the official as an elected or appointed

11 an amount equal to the compensation the official would be paid  
12 if injured in the normal course of the official's regular  
13 employment other than as an elected or appointed official, or  
14 an amount equal to one hundred forty percent of the statewide  
15 average weekly wage, whichever is greater.

17 This Act applies to personal injuries arising out of and in  
18 the course of employment sustained or incurred on or after the  
19 effective date of this Act.

20 EXPLANATION

21 The bill provides that when computing workers' compensation  
22 benefits allowed an elected or appointed official, at the  
23 official's option, the earnings as an elected or appointed  
24 official will be disregarded. If the option is chosen, the  
25 official will be paid the greater of the following amounts:  
26 an amount equal to the compensation the official would be paid  
27 if injured in the normal course of the official's regular  
28 employment, or an amount equal to 140 percent of the statewide  
29 average weekly wage.

30 The bill applies to work-related injuries sustained or  
31 incurred on or after the effective date of the bill.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 85.36, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 12. In computing the compensation to be allowed an elected or appointed official, the official may choose either of the following payment options:

a. The official shall be paid an amount of compensation based on the official's weekly earnings as an elected or appointed official.

b. The earnings of the official as an elected or appointed official shall be disregarded and the official shall be paid an amount equal to one hundred forty percent of the statewide average weekly wage.
