26 This bill changes the required issue date for the annual
27 report of state employees' salaries from September 1 to
28 November 1.

29 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

30 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

31 The Code currently requires the department of general
32 services to publish by September 1 of each year a report
33 containing the salaries of state employees. For the past two
34 years, the department has attempted to meet this deadline, but
35 it cannot be accomplished. This year incurring much overtime,

1 which tripled the cost, the publication was still three weeks
2 late. There are eight separate payroll systems which must be
3 included in this report. Also the time of year is extremely
4 busy due to the change of fiscal years which causes problems
5 in obtaining the information quickly.

RELATING TO THE DATE OF PUBLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE RE-
PORT OF STATE EMPLOYEE SALARIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 18.75, subsection 8, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

8. By ~~September~~ November 1 of each year supply a report which contains the name, gender, county or city of residence when possible, official title, salary received during the previous fiscal year, base salary as computed on July 1 of the current fiscal year, and traveling and subsistence expense of the personnel of each of the departments, boards, and commissions of the state government except personnel who receive an annual salary of less than one thousand dollars. The number of the personnel and the total amount received by them shall be shown for each department in the report. All employees who have drawn salaries, fees, or expense allowances from more than one department or subdivision shall be listed separately under the proper departmental heading. On the request of the superintendent, the head of each department, board, or commission shall furnish the data covering that agency. The report shall be paid for out of moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated. A report shall be distributed upon request without charge to each member of the general assembly and the state law library. Six copies shall be distributed without charge to the state library and one copy shall be distributed without charge to each library which is designated as a documents depository by the state library. Other persons may purchase a copy for a fee not less than the

amount required to print the copy. All funds from the sale of the report shall be deposited in the general fund.
