Section 1. Section 135C.2, Code Supplement 1989, is 2 amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 6. The department shall establish by 4 administrative rule a special license classification for units within an intermediate care facility which provide services to 6 residents with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.

Sec. 2. RULES.

The department of inspections and appeals shall adopt rules 9 which take effect immediately upon filing, or upon a later 10 date if specified in the rules, to implement section 1 of this 11 Act.

12 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes 14 effect upon enactment.

EXPLANATION

16 This bill requires the department of inspections and 17 appeals to adopt rules establishing a special license 18 classification for units within intermediate care facilities 19 which provide services to residents with Alzheimer's disease 20 and related disorders. The department is authorized to adopt 21 emergency rules to implement the special license 22 classification. The bill takes effect upon enactment.
