2 1989, is amended to read as follows:

3 The rules shall state that a hospital shall not deny
4 clinical privileges to physicians and surgeons, podiatrists,
5 osteopaths, or osteopathic surgeons, or dentists licensed
6 under chapter 148, 149, 150, 150A, or 153, solely by reason of
7 the license held by the practitioner or solely by reason of
8 the school or institution in which the practitioner received
9 medical schooling or postgraduate training if the medical
10 schooling or postgraduate training was accredited by an
11 organization recognized by the council on postsecondary
12 accreditation or an accrediting group recognized by the United
13 States department of education.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill prohibits a hospital from denying clinical
16 privileges to certain health practitioners solely by reason of
17 the school or institution in which the practitioner received
18 medical schooling or postgraduate training if the school or
19 institution was accredited.

RELATING TO CLINICAL PRIVILEGES OF CERTAIN HEALTH PRACTITIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 135B.7, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

The rules shall state that a hospital shall not deny clinical privileges to physicians and surgeons, podiatrists, osteopaths, or osteopathic surgeons, or dentists licensed under chapter 148, 149, 150, 150A, or 153, solely by reason of the license held by the practitioner or solely by reason of the school or institution in which the practitioner received medical schooling or postgraduate training if the medical schooling or postgraduate training was accredited by an organization recognized by the council on postsecondary
