9 This bill updates current references in the Code relating 10 to the redistricting process for the election of senators in 11 conformity with article III, section 6 of the Constitution of 12 the State of Iowa so that the Code references relate to the 13 1991 redistricting process. In addition the bill requires 14 that a senator who resides in an even-numbered senatorial 15 district under a plan on March 13, 1992, must reside in either 16 the plan's senatorial district which includes the place of 17 residence of the state senator on the date of the senator's 18 last election to the senate, or an even-numbered senatorial 19 district which is contiguous to such district, for the senator 20 to complete the senator's term and not be required to face an 21 election to the senate until 1994.
