1 Section 1. Section 476.6, Code 1989, is amended by adding  
2 the following new subsection:

3368-3 NEW SUBSECTION. 17. COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY MANAGEMENT  
4 REQUIRED FOR ELECTRIC UTILITIES. An electric utility shall  
5 not have a new or changed rate, charge, schedule, or  
6 regulation approved under this section unless the utilities  
7 board finds that the electric utility has in effect a  
8 comprehensive energy management program as provided under  
9 section 476A.6, subsection 4.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill requires each electric utility to have in effect  
12 a comprehensive energy management program before the utilities  
13 board may approve a new or changed rate, charge, schedule, or  
14 regulation. The comprehensive energy management program is to  
15 be designed to reduce peak loads and to increase efficiency of  
16 use of energy by all classes of customers of the utility. At  
17 a minimum, the program must include: establishment of load  
18 management and interruptible service programs, where cost  
19 effective; development of wheeling agreements and other energy  
20 sharing agreements, where cost effective, with utilities that  
21 have available capacity; establishment of cost-effective  
22 energy conservation and renewable energy services and  
23 programs; and compliance with utilities board rules on energy  
24 management procedures.

25 Similar provisions currently apply to electric utilities  
26 requesting a certificate to authorize construction of a one  
27 hundred megawatt or greater capacity electric power generating  
28 plant.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 476.6, Code 1989, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 17. COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY MANAGEMENT REQUIRED FOR ELECTRIC UTILITIES. An electric utility shall not have an increased revenue requirement finally approved under this section unless the utilities board finds that the electric utility has in effect a comprehensive energy
