

A fiscal note for SENATE FILE 397 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 397 eliminates the cap on the salaries of the Clerks of the District Court. Under this legislation, the Clerks and the Deputy Clerks would be entitled to reach the minimum of their paygrades.

Assumptions:

- 1. The Judicial Department comparable worth study would be implemented for Clerks of the District Court and their Deputies.
- 2. Those clerks and deputies whose current salary is below the minimum salary for the pay grade to which their classification has been assigned would be brought up to the minimum step.
- 3. Those clerks and deputies whose current salary fits within the pay grade to which their classification has been assigned would not be affected.

Piscal Effect:

This legislation has a fiscal effect of \$214,979. Of this amount, \$65,979 is the cost to remove the cap from the cierks' salaries, and \$149,000 is the cost to remove the cap from the deputies' salaries.
