RELATING to excursion gambling boats, by providiag LICENSING REQUIREMENTS, BY PROVIDIHG FOR THE ALLOCATION Of REVENUE, BY phoviding for the accounting of receipts, gy phoviding restrictions on the operation or gambling games, and providing a penality.

日e it enacted by the general assembly of the state of iown:

Section 1. Section 99f. A, as enacted by 1989 lowa Acts. Senate file 124, section 4, is amended by adding the following new subsections:

HEW SUESECTION. 16. To set the payout rate for all slot machines.

MEW SUBSECTION. 17. To deflne the duration of an excursion which shall be at least three hours during the excursion season. For the off season, the commission shall adopt rules lialting times of admisation to excursion gambiling boata consigtent with maximum loss per player per gambling excursion epecified in eubsection 4.

HEH BUBSECTION. 18. To provide for the continuous videotaping of all gambling activities on an excuraton boat. The videotapling ghall be performed under guldelines set by rule of the division of criminal investigation and the rules may be required that all or part of the original tapes be subaitted to the divistion on a timely schedule.

MEW SUBSECTION. 19. To provide for adequate becurity aboard each excursion gambling boat.

NEW SUBSECTION. 20. To provide that gambling games shall be conducted only during the same hours when alcoholic beverages are lawfully sold or dispensed as provided in section 123.49.

HEW SUBSECTION. 21. To establish minlmure charges for admisation to excursion gambling boate and regulate the number of free adalasions.

NEH SUBSECTION. 22. Orug teating, as permitted by section 730.5, shall be requifed periodically, not less than every sixty days, of persons employed as captalins, pilots, or physical operators of excucsion gambling boats under the provisions of thle bill.

The license shall set forth the name of the licensee, the type of license granted, the place where the excursion gambling boats will operate and dock, and the $t$ ime and number of days durling the excursion season and the of $t$ season when gambling may be conducted by the licensee. The commision ghall not allow a licensee to conduct gathbling games on an excursion gaobiling boat while docked during the off season if the licensee does not operate gambling excursions tor a mindmum number of days during the excursion season.

Sec. 3. Section 99F.7, subsection 5, paragraph c, as enacted by 1989 lowa Acts, Senate file 124, section 7, is atmended ty striking the paragraph and ingerting in lieu therest the following:
c. A section is reserved solely for activities and interestg of pergons under the age of twenty-one and is staffed to provide adequate superviston.

Sec. 4. Section 998.7, subsection 8, as enacted by 1989 Lowa Acts, Senate file 124, Bection 7 , is amended by striking the subsection and inserting in dieu thereot the following:

日. A license shall not be granted if there is substantial evidence that the applicant is not of good repute and moral character or if the applicant has pled gullty to, or has betn convicted of, a felony.

Sec. 5. Section 99F.7, subsection 10, paragraph b, as enacted by 1989 Lowa Acty, Senate file 124. section 7 , io amended by striking the paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
b. It licenses to conduct gambling games and to operate an excursion gambling boat are in effect, pursuanc to a ceferendum as set torth in this section and are subsequently diaapproved by a referendum of the county electorate, the llcenses issued by the commasion ater a referendurn approving gambling games on excureion gambling boats shall remain valid and are subject to renewal for a cotal of nine years from the date of ofiginal issue unless the commision revoken a license at an earlier date as provided 10 ehls chapter.
c. If, after the effective date of 2989 Iowa Acts, Senate File 124, section 99f.1, subsection 5, 99F.4, subsection 4 , or 998.9, subsection 2 is amended, the board of supervisory of a county in which excursion boat gambling has been approved, shall submit to the county electorate a proposition to approve or disapprove the conduct of gambling games on excurgion gambiling boata at a special election at the earliest practicable time. If excursion boat gambiling is not approved at the election, paragraph "b" does not apply to the licenses and the commisaion shall cancel the licenses issued for the county within sixty days of the unfavorable referendum.

6. A person under the age of twenty-one yearg ahall not make a wager on an excursion gambling boat and shall not be allowed in the area of the excursion boat where gambling is beling conducted.

Sec. 7. Section 99F.11, subsection 3, as enacted by 1989 Iova Acta, Senate Flle 120, section 11, la amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lleu thereof the following:
3. Three percent of the adjusted grose receipts ghall be deposited in the gamblera assistance fund apecifled in section 99E.10, subsection 1, paragraph "a".
sec. 8. Section 99f.12, unnumbered paragraph 2, as enacted by 2989 Iowa Acts, Senate Pilo 224, section 22 , is amended by strixing the unnuabered paragraph and ingerting in lieu thereof the following:

The licengee shall furnigh to the comission reports and Information as the comission may sequire with respect to its activities. The gross recelpts and adjusted gross receipts from gambling shall be separately handled and accounted for from all other moneys received from operation of an excursion gambling boat. The comaisyion may designate a repreacntative to board a licensed excursion gambling boat, who shall have full access to all places within the enclosure of the boat. who ghall directly supervise the handling and accounting of all gross receipts and adjusted gross recelpte from gambling, and who shall supervise and check the admisitons. The compensation of a representative shall be fixed by the commiasion but shall be paid by the licensee.

Sec. 9. Section 995.15, subsection 2, as enacted by 1989 Jowa Acts, Senate file 124, section $\mathbf{1 5}$, Is amended by strixing the subsection and inserting in lieu thereot the following:
2. A person knowingly permitting a person under the age of twenty-one years to make a wager is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.

Sec. 10. APPLICABILITY. This Act shall take effect oniy if Senate file 124 is enacted by the Seventy-third General Assembly.
