| 14 | SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY |
| 15 | The practice of dentistry is defined in Iowa Code section |
| 16 | 153.13 and exceptions to that definition are contained in Iowa |
| 17 | Code section 153.14. While dental students are excluded from |
| 18 | the definition of practicing dentists, and therefore exempt |
| 19 | from licensure, there is no specific exclusion for dental |
| 20 | hygiene students. The only exclusion in Iowa Code section |
| 21 | 153.14 relating to dental hygienists is in subsection 3, which |
| 22 | exempts persons licensed to practice dental hygiene from the |
| 23 | definition of the practice of dentistry. The Board assumes |
| 24 | that the legislature intended such dental hygiene students to |
| 25 | be exempt from licensure while under a course of study. |
| 26 | There being no exclusion for dental hygiene students, |
| 27 | theoretically the Board could take action against dental |
| 28 | hygiene students for practicing dental hygiene without a |
| 29 | license. The Board assumes this is a result of an oversight |
| 30 | and assumes that the legislature intended such students to be |
| 31 | exempt from licensure. |
