3 b. The title page of the district plan and a notification

EXPLANATION

17 This bill amends chapter 467A regulating soil and water  
18 conservation. Section 467A.7 requires local soil and water  
19 conservation districts to develop soil and water resource  
20 conservation plans. The bill eliminates a requirement that  
21 the plans be filed with the county where the district is  
22 located. The bill does require that the title page of the  
23 plan and a notification stating where the plan may be viewed  
24 must be filed. It also requires that the plan must be filed  
25 with the soil conservation division of the department of  
26 agriculture and land stewardship.

28 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

29 Soil and water resource conservation plans are required to  
30 be filed with local soil and water conservation districts.  
31 The plans are detailed documents that are very expensive to  
32 file with a county recorder. The plans are also subject to  
33 periodic review and change, also making it expensive to amend  
34 filings. It is adequate to record the plan's title page and  
35 provide notice of where the plan may be reviewed.
