1 Section 1. Section 384.96, Code 1991, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 384.96 SEALED BIDS.

4 When the estimated total cost to a city of a public
5 improvement exceeds the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars,
6 the governing body shall advertise for sealed bids for the
7 proposed improvement by publishing a notice to bidders as
8 provided in section 362.3, except that the notice to bidders
9 may be published more than twenty days but not more than
10 forty-five days before the date for filing bids.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill specifies that contract bidding procedures must
13 be followed when the estimated cost to a city of a public
14 improvement is more than \$25,000. Currently, the bidding
15 procedures must be followed if the estimated cost of a public
16 improvement is more than \$25,000 even though the cost to a
17 city is less than \$25,000 because a private developer is
18 financially involved with the project.

RELATING TO CONTRACT BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR A CITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 384.96, Code 1991, is amended to read
as follows:

384.96 SEALED BIDS.

When the estimated total cost to a city of a public
improvement exceeds the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars,
the governing body shall advertise for sealed bids for the
proposed improvement by publishing a notice to bidders as
provided in section 362.3, except that the notice to bidders
