AN ACT

CHANGING THE DATE BY WHICH THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A SCHOOL CORPORATION MUST DETERMINE WHETHER TO CONTINUE OR TERMINATE A TEACHING CONTRACT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 279.16, unnumbered paragraph 6, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

If the teacher fails to timely request a private hearing or does not appear at the private hearing, the board may proceed and make a determination upon the superintendent's recommendation, which determination in that case shall be not later than April ~~10~~ May 10, or not later than five days after the scheduled date for the private hearing, whichever is applicable. The board shall convene in open session and by roll call vote determine the termination or continuance of the teacher's contract.
