1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 153.15A DENTAL HYGIENISTS --  
2 LICENSE REQUIREMENTS, LICENSE RENEWAL.

3 1. In addition to requirements adopted by rule by the  
4 board, in order to obtain a license as a dental hygienist, an  
5 applicant shall present evidence to the board of both of the  
6 following:

7 a. That the applicant possesses a degree or certificate of  
8 graduation from a college, university, or institution of  
9 higher education, accredited by a national agency recognized  
10 by the council on postsecondary accreditation or the United  
11 States department of education, in a program of dental hygiene  
12 with a minimum of two academic years of curriculum.

13 b. That the applicant possesses a valid certificate in a  
14 nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

15 2. In order to renew a license as a dental hygienist, a  
16 licensee shall furnish evidence of valid annual certification  
17 for cardiopulmonary resuscitation which shall be credited  
18 toward the licensee's continuing education requirement.

28 In addition to other penalties as provided by law, a person  
29 who terminates employment of, harasses, or otherwise  
30 retaliates against a person because the person in good faith  
31 reports a suspected violation of this chapter to the board or  
32 a peer review committee is guilty of a simple misdemeanor.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill relates to the practices of dentistry and dental  
35 hygiene as regulated by the board of dental examiners.

1 Section 1 of the bill specifies minimum requirements for  
2 licensure as a dental hygienist.

3 Section 2 requires the board to adopt rules regarding in-  
4 fection control in dental practice in accordance with federal  
5 standards.

6 Section 3 subjects a person to a simple misdemeanor penalty  
7 for terminating, harassing, or otherwise retaliating against a  
8 person who in good faith reports a suspected violation of  
9 chapter 153, which regulates the practices of dentistry and  
10 dental hygiene, to the board or a peer review committee.

RELATING TO PROFESSIONS REGULATED BY THE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 153.15A DENTAL HYGIENISTS -- LICENSE REQUIREMENTS, LICENSE RENEWAL.

1. In addition to requirements adopted by rule by the board, in order to obtain a license as a dental hygienist, an applicant shall present evidence to the board of both of the following:

a. That the applicant possesses a degree or certificate of graduation from a college, university, or institution of higher education, accredited by a national agency recognized by the council on postsecondary accreditation or the United States department of education, in a program of dental hygiene with a minimum of two academic years of curriculum.

b. That the applicant possesses a valid certificate in a nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

2. In order to renew a license as a dental hygienist, a licensee shall furnish evidence of valid annual certification for cardiopulmonary resuscitation which shall be credited toward the licensee's continuing education requirement.

Sec. 2. Section 153.33, Code 1991, is amended by adding the following new subsection:
