A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the limitations on the use of the customer
2 contribution fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 476.66, subsection 1, Code 1991, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. The utilities board shall adopt rules which shall
4 require each electric and gas public utility to establish a
5 fund whose purposes shall include the receiving of
6 contributions to assist the utility's low-income customers
7 with weatherization measures to improve energy efficiency
8 related to winter heating and summer cooling, and to
9 supplement the energy assistance received under the federal
10 low-income heating energy assistance program for the payment
11 of winter heating electric or gas utility bills.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill removes the specific limitation on the use of
14 customer contribution funds for supplementation of assistance
15 received through the low-income heating energy assistance
16 program. The bill expands the use to include financial
17 assistance to low-income customers with payment for
18 weatherization measures to increase energy efficiency related
19 to winter heating and summer cooling and in payment of winter
20 heating electric or gas utility bills.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 476.66, subsection 1, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:
