3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 135C.5, Code 1991, is amended to read 2 as follows: 135C.5 HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, ETC. No-other Another business or activity shall not be carried 5 on in a health care facility, nor or in the same physical 6 structure with a health care facility except-as-hereinafter 7 provided, unless such business or activity is under the 8 control of and is directly related to and incidental to the 9 operation of the health care facility or unless the business 10 or activity is approved by the department and the state fire 11 marshal. No A business or activity which is operated within 12 the limitations of this section shall not interfere in any 13 manner with the use of the facility by the residents or the 14 services provided to the residents, nor and shall not be 15 disturbing to them. The department and the state fire 16 marshal, in accordance with chapter 17A, shall adopt rules 17 which establish criteria for approval of a business or 18 activity to be carried on in a health care facility or in the 19 same physical structure with a health care facility. 20 EXPLANATION This bill provides for the operation of certain business or 21 22 activity in a health care facility or in the same municipal 23 structure as a health care facility if the department of 24 inspections and appeals and the state fire marshal approve the 25 operation of the business or activity. The department of 26 inspections and appeals and the state fire marshal are 27 required to adopt rules which establish the criteria for such 28 approval. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

Section 1. Section 1350.5, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

1350.5 READTH CARE PACILITIES, ETC.

No-other Another business or activity shall not be carried on in a health care facility, nor or in the same physical istructure with a health care facility except-as-herernafher provided, unless such business or activity is under the control of and is directly related to and incidents, to the operation of the health care facility or unless the business or activity is approved by the department and the state tire marshal. No A business or activity which is operated within the limitations of this section shall not interfere in any manner with the use of the facility by the residents or the services provided to the residents, nor and shall not be disturbing to them. The department and the state fire rarshal, in accordance with chapter 17A, shall adopt rules which establish criteria for approval of a business or

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activity to be corried on in a health care farility or in the same physical structure with a realth care facility.
