18 For the purposes of this paragraph, a limited license is
19 deemed to be issued on the first day of the ~~fourteen-day~~
20 period for which the license is issued.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill adds two additional licenses which a qualified
23 organization may be issued to conduct games and raffles. The
24 new options are a 90-day license for a fee of \$40 and a 180-
25 day license for a fee of \$75. Only one limited license may be
26 issued to the same qualified organization in the same calendar
27 year. Currently, there are two licenses for raffles and games
28 conducted by qualified organizations. One license may be
29 issued for two years for a fee of \$150 and the other limited
30 license is issued for 14 days for a fee of \$15.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF GAMES AND RAFFLES BY QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 99B.7, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

a. A person wishing to conduct games and raffles pursuant to this section as a qualified organization shall submit an application and a license fee of one hundred fifty dollars. However, upon submission of an application accompanied by a license fee of fifteen dollars, a person may be issued a limited license ~~which shall authorize the person~~ to conduct all games and raffles pursuant to this section at a specified location and during a specified period of fourteen consecutive calendar days. In addition, a qualified organization may be issued a limited license to conduct raffles pursuant to this section for a period of ninety days for a license fee of forty dollars or for a period of one hundred eighty days for a license fee of seventy-five dollars. A limited license shall not be issued more than once during any calendar year to the same person, or for the same location. For the purposes of this paragraph, a limited license is deemed to be issued on
