A fiscal note for **House File 375** is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 375 prohibits the landfill disposal of baled waste.

## Fiscal Effect:

Very little solid waste generated in Iowa is baled before being transported to a landfill. However, if a local government baled its waste, or if a local government-operated landfill baled waste on-site before disposing of the bale in the landfill, that local government could incur a significant fiscal impact. However, very few local governments will be affected by this prohibition.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PROBLETING OF THE DISPOSAL OF BALED SOLID WASTE AT A SANITARY LANDFILL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 4550.9A DISPOSAL OF BALED SOLID WASTE AT A SANITARY LANDFILL -- PROHIBITED.

Beginning January 1, 1992, a person shall not dispose of baled solid waste at a sanitary landfill and a sanitary landfill shall not accept baled solid waste for final disposal. Solid waste which is baled on-site may be disposed of at the sanitary landfill. The department shall develop
