5 chapter if the commission or the board of supervisors  
6 determines that the person's indigency is caused by

8 at the factory, establishment, or other premises at  
9 which the person is or was last employed, unless the  
10 person is not participating in, financing, or directly  
11 interested in the labor dispute which caused the work  
12 stoppage."

10 December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, both dates inclusive;  
11 the Korean Conflict at any time between June 25, 1950, and  
12 January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive; and the Vietnam  
13 Conflict at any time between December 22, 1961, and May 7,  
14 1975, both dates inclusive; and their indigent spouses,  
15 surviving spouses, and minor children not over eighteen years  
16 of age, having a legal residence in the county.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides that the board of supervisors of each  
19 county may appropriate moneys for the food, clothing, shelter,  
20 utilities, medical benefits, and funeral expenses of honorably  
21 discharged, indigent veterans of wars and their indigent  
22 spouses, surviving spouses, and minor children not over 18  
23 years of age having legal residence in the county.

RELATING TO PERMISSIBLE USE OF MONEYS APPROPRIATED BY THE COUNTY BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE BENEFIT OF HONORABLY DISCHARGED, INDIGENT VETERANS OF WARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 250.14, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

The board of supervisors of each county may appropriate moneys for the ~~benefit of~~ food, clothing, shelter, utilities, medical benefits, and ~~to pay the~~ funeral expenses of honorably discharged, indigent persons who served in the military or naval forces of the United States in any war including World War I at any time between April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, both dates inclusive; World War II at any time between December 7, 1941, and December 31, 1946, both dates inclusive; the Korean Conflict at any time between June 25, 1950, and January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive; and the Vietnam Conflict at any time between December 22, 1961, and May 7, 1975, both dates inclusive; and their indigent spouses,
