28 This bill changes the notation on the registration plates
29 from "Pearl Harbor Veteran" to "Pearl Harbor Survivor"
30 followed by four identifying letters or numbers rather than
31 two digits of identifying numbers and removes the "Dec. 7"
32 designation.

Effective January 1, 1990, the owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, light delivery truck, panel delivery truck or pickup who was at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, as a member of the armed services of the United States on December 7, 1941, may, upon written application to the department, order special registration plates which The special registration plates shall bear the notation or emblem reading "PEARL HARBOR VETERAN SURVIVOR, DECEMBER 7, 1941"~~---The special plates shall bear the identification "HRE-7" followed by a two-digit four identifying number letters or numbers.~~ Each applicant applying for special registration plates under this subsection may purchase only one set of registration plates ~~under this subsection.~~ The application is subject to approval by the department. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the applicant shall surrender the regular registration plates to the county treasurer. The fee for the issuance of the special registration plates is twenty-five dollars which shall be in addition to the regular annual registration fee. Seriously disabled veterans who are exempted from payment of the annual registration fee under section 321.105, shall pay only the twenty-five dollar fee for issuance of the special registration plates.
