3 An advanced placement summer program is established at the  
4 state university of Iowa for purposes of training advanced

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill establishes an advanced placement summer program  
21 at the state university of Iowa. The program is to be  
22 designed to train teachers to teach advanced placement  
23 programs and to provide intensive course work for secondary  
24 students. The university is responsible for the development  
25 of appropriate curricula, provision of instructors, and other  
26 duties incidental to the creation of the program.

3 An advanced placement summer program is established at the  
4 state University of Iowa for purposes of training advanced

18 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 263.8D APPROPRIATION.

19 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to  
20 the state University of Iowa for the fiscal year beginning  
21 July 1, 1991, and ending June 30, 1992, and for each  
22 succeeding fiscal year, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand  
23 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay for  
24 program costs under section 263.8C. However, in the fiscal  
25 year, which begins July 1, 1992, and ends June 30, 1993, and  
26 in each of the next succeeding four fiscal years, the amount  
27 appropriated shall be reduced by one-fifth of the original  
28 appropriation amount, until the amount of the appropriation  
29 reaches zero.

30 EXPLANATION

31 This bill establishes, and appropriates money for, an  
32 advanced placement summer program at the state University of  
33 Iowa. The program is to be designed to train teachers to  
34 teach advanced placement programs and to provide intensive  
35 course work for secondary students. The university is

1 responsible for the development of appropriate curricula,  
2 provision of instructors, and other duties incidental to the  
3 creation of the program. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars  
4 is appropriated for the first year of the program, which will  
5 be reduced by fifty thousand dollars each year that the  
6 program is in operation, until the appropriation amount  
7 reaches zero.

**HOUSE FILE 518  
FISCAL NOTE**

A fiscal note for House File 518 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

HF 518 establishes an Advanced Placement Summer Program at the University of Iowa to train secondary advanced placement instructors and to provide course work for advanced placement students. The University of Iowa is to develop the program for the instructors and participants. The requirement is conditional upon appropriation, but not necessarily the total appropriation needed to conduct the Program.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Eighty high school students would enroll in 4 advanced placement courses for a 6-week period, at an instructor cost of \$3,000 per student.
2. Eighty teachers would attend an on-campus program at a cost of \$600 per teacher for a 1-week program.

TO ESTABLISH AN ADVANCED PLACEMENT SUMMER PROGRAM.
